PUBLIC WORKS—SEASONAL MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

Under the general guidance and direction of the director of public works, employee performs a variety of unskilled or semi-skilled tasks in the maintenance of city parks, facilities, green spaces, and other city owned and individual properties currently on the mowing program.

Operates various types of light equipment (i.e., mowers, tractors), hand tools and power tools in the maintenance of parks, city owned property, and individually owned property on the mowing program, mows lots and green areas with riding lawnmower, push mower or tractor; operates weed eater for extended periods of time, uses shovels, picks, clippers, hand pruner, chain saw and wrenches to perform duties such as edging, trimming trees and shrubs, planting trees, shrubs and flowers, repair and maintenance of equipment and playground equipment and installing playground equipment in a safe manner.

Telephone scams continue to be a serious threat. If you receive a telephone call from a bank, the IRS or anyone wanting to confirm any personal information, hang up and contact the organization back on a telephone number you know to be accurate. Do not use telephone numbers the caller supplies you to confirm their identity. A current telephone scam being used is for the scammer to contact someone and pose as a relative that is in legal trouble. The scammer then advises an attorney representing the so-called relative will be in contact to obtain monies to assist the so-called relative and then they hang up before any questions can be answered.

Identity Theft continues to be a serious threat and steps can be taken to minimize being a victim. Routinely checking your credit report yearly and placing a security freeze on your credit file through the three credit bureaus helps to minimize the damage that can occur.
